## Methods Whereby the Public May Request Information and Public Records from the Park District

Requests for information should be directed to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Officer of the Park District. The current designated FOIA Officer is:

For black and white, letter or legal sized copies, the first fifty (50) pages are free and any additional pages will cost \$0.15 per page. For color copies or abnormal size copies, the Lan-Oak Park District can charge the actual cost of copying. The Park District may require the requester to disclose whether the request is for a commercial purpose or to decide whether to grant a fee waiver.
