Planning Committee  
February 10, 2010

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Kelly at 6:30pm. Upon roll call the following were present: Committee Members: Commissioners Kelly. Guests: Commissioners Flanagin, Gaffney, John McGovern. Staff Liaison: Wilson.

Wilson introduced John McGovern of Recreation Accessibility Consultants that will be conducting the access audit for the parks and facilities of the park district. McGovern reviewed with the group the purpose of his company, the Americans with Disability Act, why the LOPD should be doing the audit, how the audit will be conducted, the bases and standards for the audit reporting, the checklist that will be used by the audit team members, and the timeline for the completion of the audit report. Various questions by the committee resulted in a discussion of the state and federal laws relating to the audit process. McGovern reviewed with the committee the actions of the Attorney General's office in regards to compliance with the ADA laws. He indicated that the findings relating to the LOPD should be placed in phases and that this would show good faith to the Attorney General's office should there ever be an ADA claim against the park district.

McGovern left the meeting at 7:10pm.

Wilson reviewed the proposed park improvements with the group for Flanagin, Oakley, Potts, Lions Stadium and Kiwanis. Discussion ensued on the proposed improvements for each park.

Wilson also updated the group regarding the letter sent to Ms, Susan Carter of Monaldi Manor Condo Association.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 7:50pm.
